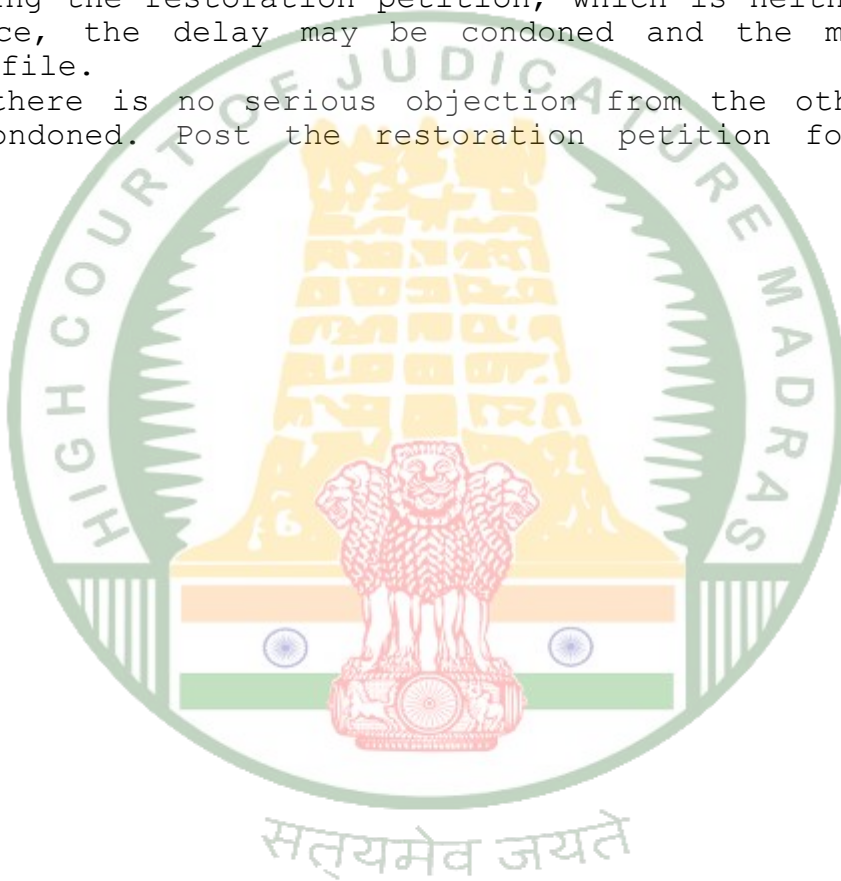

Learned Counsel for the petitioner stated that the earlier Counsel, who was presenting the matter met with an accident as a result, he was unable to attend the Court on 9.10.2018, resultantly the Tr.CMP.No.625 of 2018 was dismissed for non prosecution. Although the information was belatedly communicated, there was a delay of 22 days in filing the restoration petition, which is neither wilful nor wanton.
