Seeking a direction to the first respondent to produce the petitioner's minor daughter Sasmitha, aged about 8 years, from the illegal custody of the second respondent and hand over to the petitioner, the present habeas corpus petition has been filed.

2.When the matter is taken up for hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that nothing survives for
