by this Court. Hence, the Family Court, Salem requested three months time to dispose of the petition in H.M.O.P. No.20 of 2018.

3.Though this Court, by order dated 21.02.2019, has granted one year time to dispose of the H.M.O.P. No.20 of 2018, it is not known why the Family Court, Salem has not disposed of the same within the specified time.

4.Considering the prevailing situation, this Court is inclined to give a final chance to the Family Court, Salem to comply with the direction issued by this Court on 21.02.2019.

5.Accordingly, the Family Court, Salem is directed to dispose of the petition in H.M.O.P. No.20 of 2018 within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
