Petitioner, the detenu herein, has come forward with this petition challenging the detention order passed by the second respondent dated 27.10.2018 branding him as a "Goonda" under the Tamil Nadu Prevention of Dangerous Activities of Bootleggers, Drug Offenders, Forest Offenders, Goondas, Immoral Traffic Offenders, Sand Offenders, Slum Grabbers and Video Pirates Act, 1982 [Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982].

2.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the order of detention passed by the second respondent as against the detenu, the petitioner herein dated 27.10.2018, has

been revoked by the Government in G.O.Rt.No.5601, Home, Prohibition & Excise [XIII] Department dated 21.12.2018 and he has also produced a copy of the said order.

3.Recording the submission of the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, this petition is closed as the same has become infructuous.

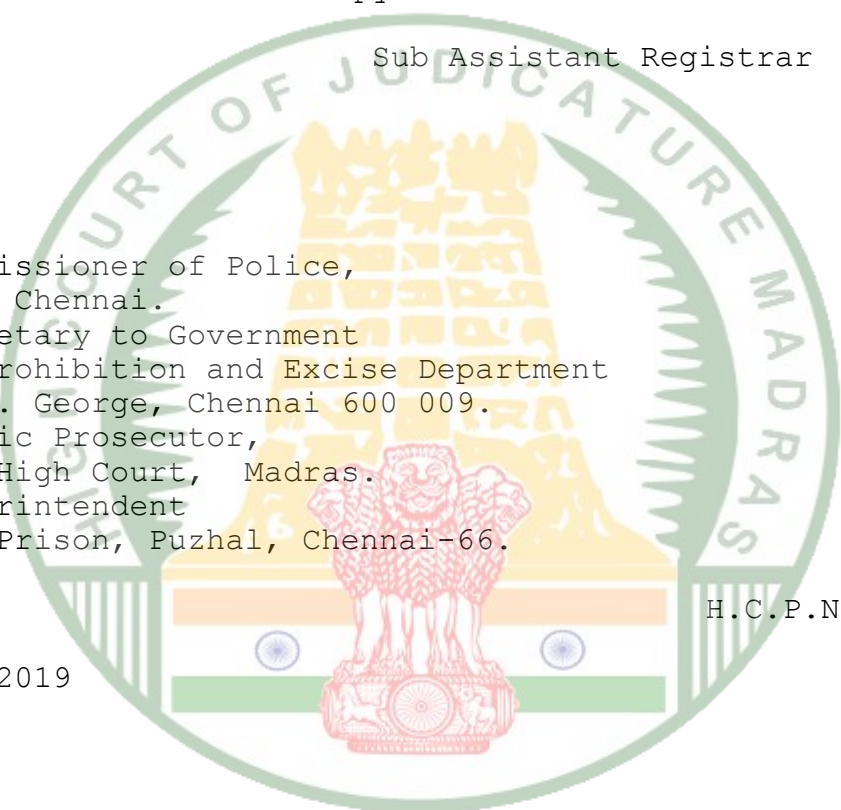
