Petitioner, mother of the detenu herein, viz., Thiru. P.Sridhar, son of Palanisamy, aged about 26 years, has come forward with this petition challenging the detention order passed by the second respondent dated 14.12.2018 against his son

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branding him as a "Drug Offender" under the Tamil Nadu Prevention of Dangerous Activities of Bootleggers, Drug Offenders, Forest Offenders, Goondas, Immoral Traffic Offenders, Sand Offenders, Slum Grabbers and Video Pirates Act, 1982 [Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982].

2.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the order of detention passed by the second respondent as against the mother of the petitioner herein dated 14.12.2018, has been revoked by the Government in G.O.Rt.No.439, Home, Prohibition & Excise [XII] Department dated 07.02.2019 and she has also produced a copy of the said order.

3.Recording the submission of the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, this petition is closed as the same has become infructuous.
