In the case on hand, already an award of Rs.16,02,240/- (Rupees sixteen lakhs two thousand two hundred and forty only) was awarded in the year 2014 by the Tribunal and now the Petitioner/appellant has filed this appeal seeking enhancement of compensation of Rs.83,97,760/-. We find no reason to exempt the Petitioner from paying the court fee, as sought for.

4. In the result, this application is dismissed.
