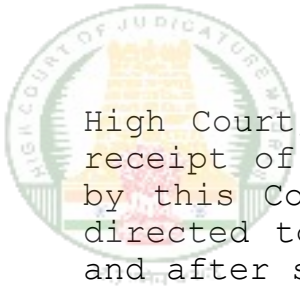
This Civil Miscellaneous Petition has been filed to condone the delay of 256 days in paying the deficit Court fee of Rs.6,180/- in the above said appeal.
