2. Recording the above, this Criminal Appeal is dismissed as abated.

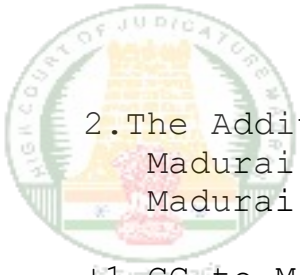
