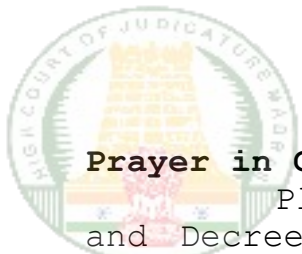

2.This Court, in C.M.P(MD)No.12126 of 2018, vide order, dated 19.12.2018, granted an order of interim stay on condition that the petitioner / appellant shall deposit the entire award amount with accrued interest and costs to the credit of M.C.O.P.No.197 of 2017 on the file of the Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of the order.
