PRAYER IN CMA(MD) No.SR38714 of 2017:-

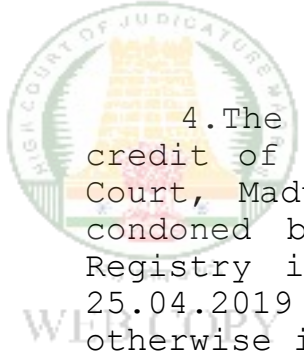
