PRAYER IN C.M.P (MD) No.4252 of 2019 in C.M.A (MD) No.SR14155 of 2018:

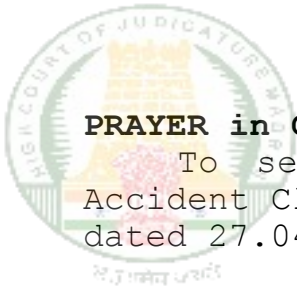
