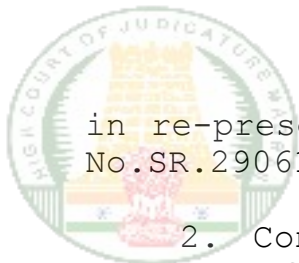
PRAYER IN CMA(MD) No.SR29061 of 2018:-
