ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who is arrayed as accused, apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent for the alleged offence punishable under Section 379 IPC in Cr.No.53 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that on an earlier occasion, on 19.12.2018, this Court granted anticipatory bail to the petitioner in Crl.O.P.(MD)No.22412 of 2018, however, the petitioner is not in a position to produce surety within a time. Hence, the petitioner filed the present anticipatory bail petition.

3.In view of the above, the anticipatory bail already granted is extended for a further period of two weeks. The other conditions imposed in Crl.O.P.(MD)No.22412 of 2018, are unaltered. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
