2.In view of the above submission, this Criminal Appeal is dismissed as infructuous.

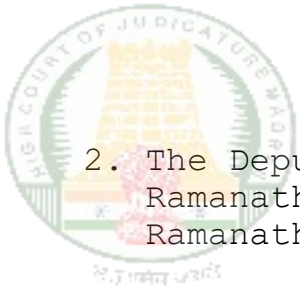
