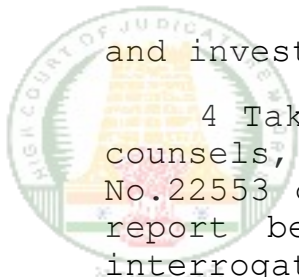
ORDER:-
