PRAYER IN CRL MP(MD).No.1817 OF 2019:-

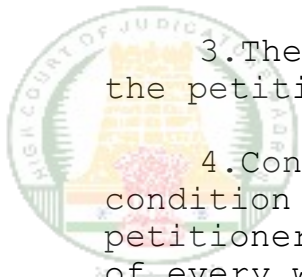
