Prayer in CRL OP(MD). 1878 of 2019 :

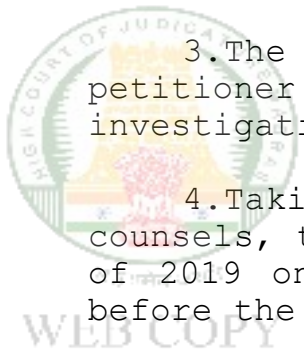
