4.Taking into consideration of the submissions made by both the counsel, the condition imposed by this court in Crl.O.P.(MD) No.17814 of 2018 on 22.02.2019 is modified to that effect that the second



petitioner is directed to report before the respondent police once in a week, i.e., **every Monday at 10.30.a.m. until further orders** and the first petitioner shall report before respondent police as and when required for interrogation.
