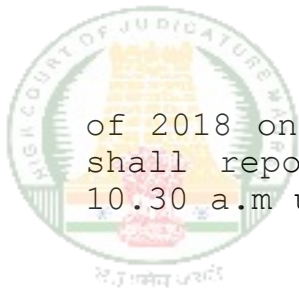
This petition has been filed to relax the condition imposed on the petitioner in Crl.O.P.(MD)No.18986 of 2018 on 11.02.2019.
