Side) on behalf of the Respondent, the court made the following order:-

This petition has been filed to modify the condition imposed on the petitioner in Crl.O.P.(MD)No.3558 of 2018 on 07.03.2019 to the effect that the petitioner shall appear before the All Women Police, Kanjupuram Town instead of the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police, Dindigul.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is the residents of Kanjipuram. He has faced very hardship to appear before respondent police, Dindigul. The other condition shall remain unchanged.
