Heard both sides.

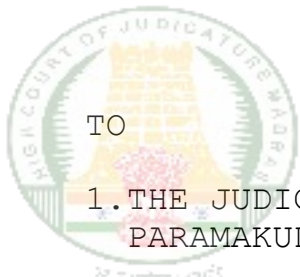
2.According to the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side), the petitioner is complying with the condition imposed by this Court regularly.
