2.Heard Mr.M.Suresh, learned Counsel for the petitioner and Mr.A.Robinson, learned Government Advocate (Crl Side) appearing for the State.

3.According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the abovesaid condition is being complied with by the petitioner right from 23.04.2019 till date and therefore, the learned counsel seeks for relaxation. This fact has not been disputed by the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side).

Taking into consideration of the fact that the condition imposed by this Court is being complied with by the petitioner and the fact that the substantial portion of investigation has also been completed, the condition imposed by this Court vide order in CrI.O.P.(MD)No.5230 of 2019 on 16.04.2019 is modified and the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police once in a week i.e., on every Monday at 10.30 a.m., for a period of four weeks.
