Taking into consideration of the fact that the condition imposed by this Court is being complied with by the petitioner and the fact that substantial portion of the investigation has also been completed, the condition imposed by this Court in CrI.O.P.(MD) No.5550 of 2019 on 12.04.2019 is relaxed and the petitioner/s shall appear before the respondent police as and when required.
