3.According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the abovesaid condition is being complied with by the petitioner right from 13.01.2019 till date and therefore, the learned counsel seeks for relaxation. This fact has not been disputed by the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side).

Taking into consideration of the fact that the condition imposed by this Court is being complied with by the petitioner and the fact that substantial portion of the investigation has also been completed, the condition imposed by this Court in Crl.O.P.(MD) No.21800 of 2018 on 10.12.2018 is modified and the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police twice in a Month at 10.30 a.m., for a period of four weeks.
