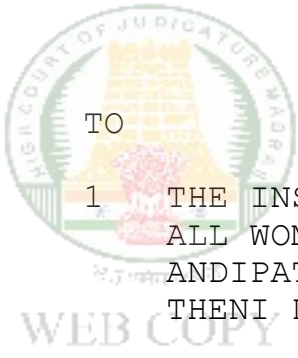
3.Recording the submission made by the learned Government Advocate(Crl.side), this Criminal Original Petition is closed.
