3.The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that no part of the FIR provides any ingredients of the offences as



indicated above.

On carefully going through the FIR, this Court finds that there are *prima facie* materials for the specific overt act attributed to each of the accused / petitioners herein necessary for constituting offences. Since the investigation is not yet completed, this is too premature to consider the grievance or otherwise of the allegations made in the FIR

5. Hence, this petition is dismissed. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is also closed.
