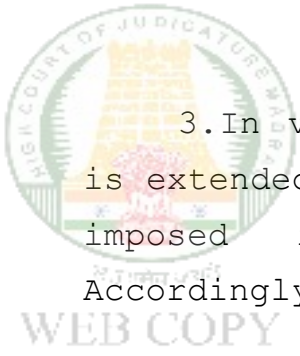
PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who is arrayed as accused, apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 323, 498(A), 355, 506(ii) of IPC and Section 4 of TNPHW Act in Crime No. 9 of 2018, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that on an earlier occasion, on 11.12.2018, this Court granted anticipatory bail to the petitioner in Crl.O.P.(MD) No.20645 of 2018, however, the petitioner is not in a position to produce surety within a time. Hence, the petitioner filed this second anticipatory

bail petition



3. In view of the above, the anticipatory bail already granted is extended for a further period of two weeks. The other conditions imposed in Crl.O.P.(MD)No.20645 of 2018, are unaltered. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
