PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who is arrayed as accused, apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 323 of IPC and Section 4 of Women Harassment Act in crime No.4 of 2019 , seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that an on earlier occasion, on 29.01.2019, this Court granted anticipatory bail to the petitioner in Crl.O.P.(MD)No.1340 of 2019, however, the petitioner is not in a position to produce surety within a time. Hence, the petitioner filed this second anticipatory bail petition.
