The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents submitted that neither a complaint nor any case is pending against the petitioners on the file of the respondent police and the first respondent is neither harassing the petitioners nor interested in harassing the petitioners whatsoever.

5. In view of the submission made by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, it is made clear that now the presence of the police is not necessary to the respondent police either for interrogation or for enquiry.
