PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec. 439 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who was arrested on 21.02.2019 for the offences punishable under Sections 8(c) r/w 20(b)(ii)(C) and 25 of NDPS Act in Crime No. 15 of 2019 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. It is the case of the prosecution that the petitioner is alleged to have found in possession of 21 Kgs of Ganja

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and he has nothing to do with the alleged offence. He would further submit that the petitioner have been in custody since 21.02.2019 and therefore, the petitioner may be granted bail.

4. The learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side) submitted that the quantity involved in commercial quantity and he opposed to grant bail to the petitioner.

5. Taking into consideration, the nature and gravity of offence and the quantity involved is commercial quantity and there is no change of circumstances in the said case, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.



6. Hence the bail application is dismissed.
