PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offence punishable under Sections 498(A) and 506(i) of IPC in Crime No.Not known of 2019, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The contention of the petitioners is that the defacto complainant is the daughter in law of the first petitioner. The first petitioner's son and the defacto complainant got married on 09.09.2018. After three months, the husband of the defacto complainant / son of the first left to Dubai for his job. Since he did not contact with the defacto complainant, she made a false allegation that the petitioners were demanding more dowry and ill



treated her.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) would submit that there is no complaint as on date.

4.Recording the said submission, this Criminal Original Petition is closed.
