2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. side).

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the second respondent police is harassing the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. side) submitted that a complaint was preferred by the third respondent and the same is being enquired in current paper. He further submitted that summon was issued to both parties and petition enquiry was conducted and it was closed. He added that the respondent police have not harassed the petitioner and they have no intention to harass him.
