Prayer:Criminal Original Petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., to direct the respondent not to harass the petitioners in guise of enquiry.

Government Advocate (CrI.Side)**ORDER**

This petition has been filed seeking a direction to the first respondent not to harass the petitioners under the guise of enquiry.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate (CrI.Side) appearing for the respondent.

3. The learned Government Advocate (CrI.Side) submitted that on the complaint given by the defacto complainant against the petitioners, petition enquiry is pending in C.S.R.No.69/2019 on the file of the respondent police.

4. Under such circumstances, blanket order of "not to harass" cannot be passed. The petitioner is directed to cooperate with the police for enquiry and at the time of conducting enquiry, the petitioner shall not be harassed. During the course of enquiry, if any cognizable offence is made out, the respondent police is free to register an FIR and this order shall not be a shield for the petitioner against arrest.



5. With the above direction, the Criminal Original Petition is closed.
