3. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner is now directed to approach the trial Court and state the reasons and have the warrants recalled.

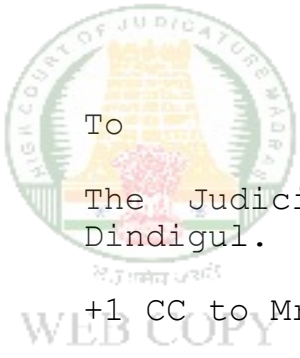
4. Accordingly, these Criminal Original Petitions are disposed of.
