PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

4. The petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation.

5. If the respondent police intends to proceed further they can act in accordance with the procedure laid down under Section 41 (A) of Cr.P.C.
