PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

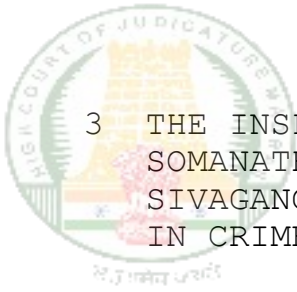
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner/accused no.1, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 323 and 506(i) of IPC, in Crime No.23 of 2019 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.Heard Mr.V.Karuna, learned Counsel for the petitioner and Mr.A.Robinson, learned Government Advocate (Crl Side) appearing for the State.

3.The case of the prosecution is that due to wordy quarrel between the defacto complainant and the accused, the petitioner attacked the defacto complainant and thereby, the defacto complainant sustained injuries and admitted in the hospital. Hence, the complaint.

4.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is an innocent and he did not commit any offence as alleged by the prosecution and he has been falsely implicated in this case. Hence, he prays to grant anticipatory bail to this petitioner.
