This Criminal Original Petition has been filed seeking a direction to the second respondent Police not to harass the petitioner illegally under the guise of enquiry.

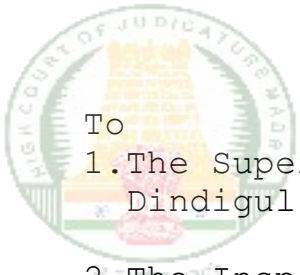
