ORDER

The third respondent refused to accept the said marriage and apprehending life threat at his hand, the petitioner made a representation before the second respondent on 10.06.2019 seeking police protection. 3. Today, when the matter was taken up for consideration, the learned counsel appearing for the third respondent submitted that now the third respondent accepted the marriage of the petitioner with Suresh @ Mohamed Sarfaraz and there is no threat to the petitioner.

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4. In view of the submission made by the learned counsel appearing for the third respondent, this Criminal Original Petition is closed, as no further order is necessary.
