2.Heard both sides.

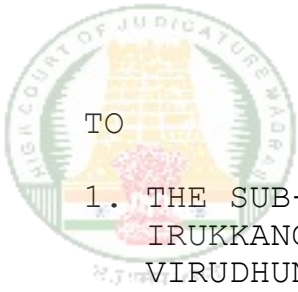
