2. The grievance of the petitioners is that based on the complaint given by the third respondent / daughter-in-law of the first petitioner, the second respondent Police directed the petitioners to appear for enquiry and thereby harassing them.

Today, when the matter was taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate (Crl. side) appearing for the respondents 1 and 2 on instructions, submitted that based on the complaint given by the third respondent, the complaint has been enquired and after the enquiry, the same was closed by the second respondent Police. He further submitted that both the parties have settled their dispute between themselves.
