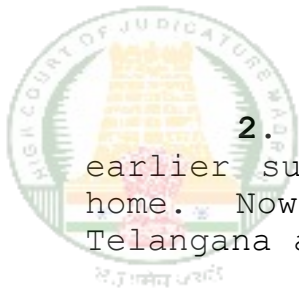

Sakthivel and Ramasamy have filed H.C.P.(MD) Nos.279 of 2019 and Nos.283 of 2019 respectively stating that their daughters Kaviya, aged about 17 years and Vanitha, aged about 17 years, respectively, went missing.



2. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor, on instructions, earlier submitted that out of exam fear, the detenues left their home. Now, on information, the Police have secured the detenues at Telangana and also produced them before this Court.

3. When we enquired, the detenues stated that they are willing to go with their parents. Since the detenues are minors, their custody has been handed over to their parents.

4. In view of the above, the Habeas Corpus Petitions are closed. This Court places on record its appreciation to Mr.B.Sivakumar, Inspector of Police, Vadamadurai Police Station, Dindigul District, for the efforts taken by him to trace the detenues at the earliest.
