Today, When the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor produced a copy of the statement said to have been made by the detenu Aarthi. In the said statement, she had alleged that her marriage with the petitioner was solemnized under coercive circumstances and that she did not consent for the same. The detenu is not a minor. It is for the petitioner to seek relief as against the detenu elsewhere. Filing of this Habeas Corpus Petition is misconceived. The Habeas Corpus Petition stands dismissed accordingly.
