ORDER

This writ petition is filed, seeking to direct the respondents to provide the eligible retirement benefits of the petitioner's husband along with other consequential monetary benefits with suitable interest, within the time stipulated by this Court.

2. Mrs.J. Padmavathy Devi, learned Special Government Pleader takes notice for the respondents. By consent, the writ petition is taken up for disposal at the admission stage itself.

3. Though this petition has been filed to give a positive direction to the respondents, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner will be satisfied, if a direction is issued to the respondents, to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 28.01.2019.



4. Having regard to the limited scope of the prayer, that is now sought before this Court by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, which has been agreed by the learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the respondents, this Court, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, directs the first respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 28.01.2019 on merits and in accordance with law, and pass necessary orders, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

5. With the above direction, the writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
