3.Accordingly, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.

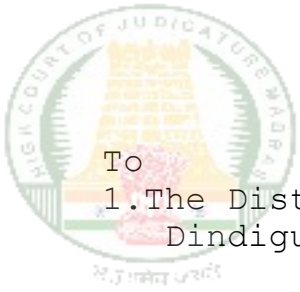
