This Writ Petition has been filed seeking a direction to the respondents to grant permission and protection for cultural event, namely Adalpadal scheduled to be held on 06.06.2019 at night 09.00 p.m., to 12.00 a.m., in connection with "Vaikasi Festival" in Arulmighu Sri Azhiyamozhiamman Kovil at Kattumavadi Village, Manamelkudi Taluk, Pudukkottai District, based on the petitioner's representation dated 17.05.2019.

2. Heard both sides.

The grievance of the petitioner is that seeking permission and police protection to conduct the cultural event on 06.06.2019 in connection with "Vaikasi Festival" in Arulmighu Sri Azhiyamozhiamman Kovil at Kattumavadi Village, Manamelkudi Taluk, Pudukkottai District, the petitioner has given a representation on 17.05.2019 to the second respondent and the said representation was



not considered so far. Hence, the present Writ Petition has been filed for the aforesaid relief.
