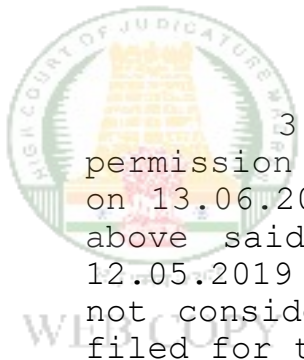

This Writ Petition has been filed seeking a direction to the second respondent to grant permission and protection for cultural event, namely Aadalpadal scheduled to be held on 13.06.2019 at night in connection with "Vaikaasi Urchava Festival" in Arulmigu Sri Manthaiamman and Paramasivan Temple at Valluvar Colony, Karuvelnayakanpatti Village, Kunnur Post, Theni Taluk, Theni District, by considering the petitioner's representation dated 12.05.2019.

The grievance of the petitioner is that seeking permission and police protection to conduct the Adal Padal programme on 13.06.2019 in connection with "Vaikaasi Urchava Festival" of the above said temple, the petitioner has given a representation on 12.05.2019 to the second respondent and the said representation was not considered so far.
