ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed seeking a direction to the respondents to grant permission and protection for cultural event, namely Adalpadal scheduled to be held on 14.06.2019 at night 09.00 p.m, to 12.00 a.m., in connection with "Vaikasi Festival" in Arulmigu Sri Sathai Uyyavanthamman Temple at Mangala Vinayagar Street, Pudhuvayal Village, Karaikudi Taluk, Sivagangai District, by considering the petitioner's representation dated 21.05.2019.

2. Heard both sides.

The grievance of the petitioner is that seeking permission and police protection to conduct the Adal Padal programme on 14.06.2019 in connection with "Vaikaasi Festival" of the above said temple, the petitioner has given a representation on 21.05.2019 to the second respondent and the said representation was not considered so far. Hence, the present Writ Petition has been filed

for the aforesaid relief.

4. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, without going into the merits of the case, the second respondent is directed to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 21.05.2019 and pass suitable orders on merits and in accordance with law, forthwith.

5. The Writ Petition stands disposed of with the above direction. No costs.
