The grievance of the petitioner is that seeking permission and police protection to conduct the Adal Padal programme on 14.06.2019 in connection with " Kumbabishegam Festival" of the above said temple, the petitioner has given a representation on 24.05.2019 to the second respondent and the said representation was not considered so far.
