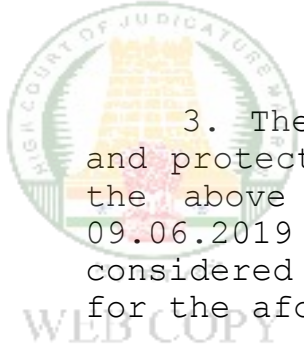

The grievance of the petitioner is that seeking permission and protection to conduct the Adal Padal Programme on 07.07.2019 in the above said temple, the petitioner made a representation on 09.06.2019 to the respondents and the said representation was not considered so far.
