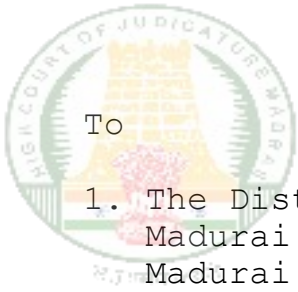
ORDER
